HIGHLIGHTS OF SCHOOL OUTREACH PROGRAMS

PILOT VISIT



Pilot visit is the initial part of our activity where around 4 to 5 volunteers will be visiting the school and the students to know about the school needs and student's session requirements, where we spend 15 minutes of our time in each classroom. Altogether here we finalize the needs of the school and will further plan for the event.

EVENT

Event is an important activity after our pre-visit. Hope trust team of 10+ people will travel to the schools on the date specified by the school management and execute our event activities as follows.

- Motivational session
- Career guidance sessions
- Psychological sessions
- Personality development training
- Donating the school of their requested needs.
- Gifts to school students and teachers

After successful completion of our event, we further support the school, students based on the situation and needs, where that make the students to feel free and clarify their doubts and knowing more about their career opportunities





PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT TRAINING




Personality development training activities for students ensures that they get the benefits of this life-changing experience early in life. Understanding self and their strengths, weaknesses and core motivations right at the start of your career will help you achieve your life goals more quickly and easily.

- Communicate with clarity and confidence.
- Project a confident and enthusiastic demeanor.
- Learn to focus on and process new information.

CAREER GUIDANCE SESSIONS

The main aim of this session is to help students to choose a field that is in tune with their passion along with their abilities and expectations. This session helps most students end up choosing the right career and perform their level best, which ultimately helps them succeed.

- Help you figure out who you are and what you want out of your education, your career and your life.
- Help you identify the factors influencing your career development and help you assess your interests, abilities and values.
- Help you to locate resources wherever and sources of career information.
- Help you to determine next steps and develop a plan to achieve your goals.

PSYCHOLOGICAL SESSIONS

It's an essential problem-solving session. Students describe their current situation and their feelings about it and then our volunteers use their expertise to assist students in trying to resolve that problem so you can move closer to having the life you wish to have.

We typically invite students to share what's been going on in their life, what's on their mind, what's bothering them, or whether there any goals you'd like to discuss. They'll be invited to speak openly.



These sessions are tailored to provide the training to the mass and individual students to get benefitted as per their understanding and ability Eg: Overcome Laziness, Over Achiever High Performer etc.

Now we walk you through the process of the event, we follow the protocol described for the events regardless of the place, venue and the number of students in the school. Before the actual event take place, the Pilot visit is the essential step we follow for every place, then the planning is done according to the requirement gathered at the pilot visit. And actual event will be scheduled published to the volunteers for their preparation, then the event 'll start according the schedule.

MOTIVATIONAL/AWARENESS SESSIONS

Motivational sessions allow students to prepare for their "Community Life". It is a moment of relaxation, reflection and contemplation. The main objectives of this session can be summarized as follows:

- Learn more about themselves
- Learn about others and their disabilities
- Learn to accept what they are and how they are
- Learn about positive thinking
- Must be convinced that they "CAN DO" what they want if they set their mind to do it.
- Learn to resolve mindfulness problems









NEEDY HUNTERS (NH)

This team is the alpha team of the trust. They are the ones who'll identify the location of under privileged villages and other institution that is in need of our service. They even take a general survey on the present need of the society and let the board members aware of; the board will further look onto it.

EVENT MANAGEMENT (EM)

This team will entirely work on organizing a cultural and educational extravaganza. They will manage the event according to the funds available. They are expected to organize a neat show.

FUND RAISING (FR)

This team mainly concentrates on the financial aspects of the Trust, by means of handling all the in and out financial transactions in transparent manner under the administration of President. The main responsibility of this team is to raise fund on monthly basis with the support of our valuable trust members and maintain the ledger report of the fund raised, also helps to allocate the budget to the planned events of the Trust and helps to establish the name of our Trust during the disasters.



INTERNAL STRENGTHENING - CORE [IS-CORE]

Internal Strengthening Team works as Training and Research department of the Trust; it mainly concentrates on the internal and external trainings. Also helps to print remarkable presence of our Trust by means of sharing wisdom as a social service. Volunteers in this amazing team are moulded in specific/special skill set which can be fed to the society, team focused to prove the power of sharing the knowledge, to see the healthy and literate future generation.

INTERNAL STRENGTHENING CAREER EMULATORS [IS-CE]

Volunteers in this team works in preparing career guidance charts and Documents in-depth for post 10th & 12th.Training the career guidance trainers. Gradually started our work to emulate college students and women empowerment trainings.

INTERNAL STRENGTHENING TECH SAVVY [IS-TS]

Volunteers in this team works in Digital Marketing, Social Media Marketing (Face book, Instagram, LinkedIn, Google My Business, YouTube etc.), Websites and Task Automation. Posting the Event Information in the Website, Facebook, Instagram is our Primary work. Sharing Birthday post for the volunteers and Well wishers. Preparing Pamphlets, Invitation, Brochures for Fund Raising and etc. Posting the Videos in YouTube by editing as per the new Trends. Maintains the Photos and Videos of each activity.

INTERNAL STRENGTHENING SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETERS [IS-SLI]

Volunteers in this team get trained in british sign language. Preparing signs language presentation for our IS session psychological topics and motivational topics.



ADMINISTRATION [ADMIN]

Administration team maintains the saviors of the legal and evidence documents of the Trust regulatory. They maintain repository of the enrolments, identity, terminations, key details of the volunteers and other donors like contact, bank details. They also help other team by providing the prospectus and pamphlets with the required details of the planned events, also extend their help by fulfilling the document requirements of the other teams.

ADMIN - VOLUNTEER COORDINATION [ADMIN-VC]

This team helps to onboard the new volunteers to the trust & guide them with the standard procedures of joining. Manages the grievance redressal for our volunteers. Helps for the separation process of the volunteers.



The Program "Mission for the Employment of Tribal Youth" is an initiative launched by The Government of Tamil Nadu's Tribal Welfare Department, in collaboration with Hope Trust, to support tribal candidates in securing employment after graduation or dropped out for various situations. The program focuses on enhancing employability skills through vocational training, career counseling and job placement assistance. Key components include soft skills development, technical training, resume building and interview preparation, tailored to industry demands. By bridging the gap between education and employment, Program empowers tribal youth with the necessary skills and opportunities to achieve sustainable livelihoods, fostering socio-economic growth in tribal communities. Furthermore, we will be visiting the centers often to monitor the student's progress, motivate them and provide continuous support to ensure their successful training and employment outcomes.

With the help of Tamil Nadu's Tribal Welfare Department, Panchayat Leaders, Village Heads, Tribal Welfare team, District Tribal Welfare Officers/Deputy Collectors and Tribal School Head Masters and Teachers, we (Hope Trust) collected the details and contacted 584 candidates individually via phone call, elaborated about the program and requested them to join the orientation program.

After this, the employability skills training orientation programs were conducted by Tamil Nadu's Tribal Welfare Department, in association with the Hope Trust and Naandhi Foundation, which conducted a screening for tribal candidates based on their interest in two different locations (**Kanyakumari,Trichy & Salem**), where **750** candidates participated.

After screening, an inauguration program was organized by the Tamil Nadu Government Skill Development Corporation in two different locations (Chennai & Namakkal), where 150 candidates attended and they were sent to Nettur Technical Training Foundation, Bangalore (NTTF) for employability skills training for tribal youth, in which courses were offered in two verticals, Computer Numerical Control (CNC) and Customer Relationship Management (CRM), for 4 months and the candidates were successfully placed in high-paying jobs in reputable organizations.







The "Tholkudi Thoduvaanam" is a strategic initiative spearheaded by the Government of Tamil Nadu's Tribal Welfare Department, aimed at empowering tribal youth to secure meaningful employment opportunities. Targeting both graduates and those who have discontinued their education due to various circumstances, the program is dedicated in bridging the critical gap between education and employment. Furthermore, we will be visiting the centers often to monitor the student's progress, motivate them and provide continuous support to ensure their successful training and employment outcomes.

Tholkudi Thoduvaanam offers a comprehensive suite of services, including industry-relevant vocational training, personalized career counseling and robust job placement support. Core components of the program encompass soft skills development, sector-specific technical training, resume building and intensive interview preparation, all of which are meticulously tailored to meet current industry demands.

With the help of Tamil Nadu's Tribal Welfare Department, Panchayat Leaders, Village Heads, Civil Society, District Tribal Welfare Officers and Tribal School Head Masters and Teachers, District Adi-Dravidar Welfare Officers/Deputy Collectors organized the 3091 tribal youth and brought them to the various mobilization camps across 19 districts of Tamil Nadu.

Based on their interest, the **650+ candidates** were sent to 12 different training centers in which 20 courses were offered.





A Malaiyaali's mettle

Rajesh from the Malaiyaali tribe at Manjakkal village in Yelagiri, is a first-generation graduate. His father, a farmer, earns <3,750 a month. Despite their best efforts, the family struggles to make ends meet after covering essential expenses like groceries and bills. "There have been "There have been moments when we couldn't afford to buy medicines," says Rajesh. But Rajesh believes all that is going to change. Now pursuing a degree in metallurgy, a seat he managed to get because of the coaching he got at his GTR school, Rajesh says he plans to build a career in the

plans to build a career in the industry and provide for his family. "I now see hope," he says.

wo years ago if you asked Vengateshwaran S if he ever thought he would be an engineer, he would have said no. Hailing from Kizhur village in Tirupattur and belonging to the Malaiyaall tribe, the journey, as he and most others from his community would tell you, was almost unthinkable given their families 'financial struggles.' Most of us just give up and begin doing odd jobs to keep our families afloat or to look after ailing elders. Getting coached for college entrance exams is unaffordable," says Vengateshwaran. gateshwaran

says Vengateshwaran.

His life took a turn for the better
when he heard about the professional
coaching classes that were being
launched in his Govt Tribal Residential
(GTR) higher secondary school. Vengateshwaran signed on for JEE training,
and today is pursuing a metallurgy and
material engineering course at MTE. material engineering course at NIT, Trichy. "Who would have thought?" he

says.
Over the years, with the pass rate at Over the years, with the pass rate at TN's GTR higher secondary schools in-creasing — this year, it was 95.1% across 36 GTR schools, one of the highest ever students from tribal communities are —students from triou communities are finding hope in govt education pro-grammes. In response to the challenges of unemployment and educational

disparities among tribal com munities, last August, state govt initiated training for GTR higher see GTR higher secondary stu-dents in NEET and JEE. dents in NEET and JEE.
This year, 447 students appeared for the JEE and 118
for the NEET exams. Of
them, more than 40 have
qualified to attend the advanced JEE exam. GTR and
Eklavya Model Residential Schools.

Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) are located in 14 districts, in-cluding Dharmapuri, Erode, Coim-batore, Dindigul and the Nilgiris. Many students from these tribal com-munities are first-generation learners, and so it becomes crucial to create a safe space for them to feel comfortable, says S Annadural, director of state tribal welfare department. "In 2023, only 67 students wrote the JEE exam. We want-ed to up those numbers, so we focused



on providing them with NEET and JEE on providing them with NEE 1 and 3EE coaching every day for an hour and gave one-on-one training to students who were finding it difficult to understand the concepts. The students were also given reference books, question banks, and previous years' question papers," he says.

To improve the quality of the coach-

To improve the quality of the coaching at all the schools, govt is also working on having video conferencing facilities to help students learn from the best of faculities for competitive exams. Besides focusing on competitive exams such as JEE, NEET, NIFT, CUET, IELTS and CLAT, the GTR schools also organise lectures for results subject.

"I completed my BCom degree more than five years ago, but could not get a job. I recently learned about job training opportunities, and I'm positive that I'll secure a voice processing role through placements, "says 27-year-old M Kaliyap-pan, a member of the irular tribe from Chenzalpet.

Non-profits too are stepping in. Chen-nal-based non-profit Hope Trust: To-gether We Can, with the support of Ta-mil Nadu govt, has been organising three-month residential training pro-grammes for job aspirants from tribal communities at the Nettur Technical Tec Training Foundation in Bengaluru. Students are offered two courses: technical (CNC operator) and non-technical (cus-tomer relationship management roles).

tomer relationship management roles).

"The batch from the tribal community will be done with their programme next month and we'll begin our placement drives," says Sathish Kumar, founder of Hope Trust.

"These programmes should be made accessible in all villages across TN. Unfortunately, many are not aware of this initiative," says R Rajangam, founder of The Empowerment Centre of Nomads and Tribes.

he journey from a small tuition center to an NGO that helps tribal communities in Tamil Nadu has been filled with both challenges and successes. That is the journey of what is now Hope Trust, and also that of its founder, Satish Kumar S.

Satish Kumar, an IT professional, began with Hope Tuition Center, focusing on teaching core subjects. He organised entertainment events at various government schools. With an office in Kolathur, Hope Trust's young volunteers work for free, using public tran-sport and staying on school premises with the community.

"Our main goal is to highlight

the importance of education for tribal communities. Our enthusiastic team has visited many tribal-run schools, even those in remote forests. We have collaborated with the Tribal Welfare departments to promote various schemes for these communities. This experience not only benefits society but also helps our city-based volunteers develop leadership and public speaking skills. We organise entertainment events and donate essentials like printers, water tanks, and boards. Volunteers travel by public tran-sport and stay at the schools to adapt to basic living conditions, which they enjoy. Our significant project involved job training pro-grams at an IT park in Bangalore, resulting in many placements with good salaries," says Satish Kumar.

"Together We Can"













